In response to COVID19 The Outside Project expanded to become a 24hour service. We also opened an emergency refuge for the LGBTIQ+ community fleeing domestic abuse in London. We have secured longer term funding and are looking to recruit a new support team to move forward at an exciting developing time for the organisation.

Transience and exclusion prevent many LGBTIQ+ people from establishing the roots and social networks that others in society rely on. Our community have created a culture of 'queer family' through peer support and mutual aid in response. Our project bridges the gap between this culture and professional support provision. This is an exciting opportunity to gain experience working in a unique service led by and for the LGBTIQ+ community here in London.

Job description:

- You will provide advice and support to people who are in crisis, developing a risk assessment, support plan and resettlement plan with people experiencing homelessness and survivors of domestic abuse accessing the refuge.
- You will facilitate daily group meet-ups and wellbeing activities and have a knowledge of other useful groups and support services for survivors of DVA that are accessible to the LGBTIQ+ community.

Requirements:

- Minimum of one-year experience of working within the homelessness or domestic abuse services.
- Understanding the housing needs of LGBTIQ+ people who experience homelessness or domestic abuse.
- Experience in managing risks, challenging behaviour and multi agency team working.
